2023 Season

I would like to congratulate all of you on another wonderful season. I would also like to congratulate all of our members who traveled to any of the WGI events. If you have not taken your group to a Regional, I encourage all of you to do so.

Regular Season Competitions

Of the options that we have discussed we believe that splitting the Scholastic and Independent groups is the best option. - 2) Contest Weekends. Having a West Side/East Side weekend is something that we need to look at. There are multiple issues that occur when we do this, and I believe that we should only hold these if they are absolutely necessary.
